Students can bring wax carving tools if they like, which can be stainless steel, steel and wood carving tools. That are used to refine the details on the wax sculptures.

With the direct wax sculpting, metal and wood tools will be used. Some of the metal tools may be heated up to cut through and make impressions in the wax. Also a small kitchen knife will work for cutting the wax and working with it (just be sure it's a knife you don't need, as it will get a lot of wax on it). Homemade tools fabricated and forged in steel or stainless steel will work, as well as homemade wood tools.
