Class Description:

This workshop will use various inks and pen types to produce ink drawings, representing form and shape by building value and texture with the ink and paper. Emphasis will be placed on pen stroke techniques to produce form, texture, shape, value, and points of interest.

Course Goals:

Introduce students to tips and techniques for creating a drawing with pen & ink and to strengthen your drawing skills while discovering the versatility of this fast, indelible medium.

Class:

Instruction will focus on using pen strokes to produce shapes, values, texture and center of interest in an ink drawing.

Upon completion of this course, students will:

Become acquainted with the use of the pen to create form, texture, shape and values

Required Materials:

- Pen – Sharpie Twin Tip or Identi-pen or similar
- Paper – Bristol Pad (plate or smooth)
- Pencil – 2B
