



PreCollege Provides a Substance-Free, Tobacco-Free Environment

CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT

- Ringling College of Art and Design is dedicated to maintaining a learning community that promotes intellectual inquiry through vigorous discourse. Essential values of this community include civility, dignity, diversity, education, equality, freedom, honesty and safety. Behaviors that are inconsistent with the essential values of this community are considered misconduct and will result in disciplinary action. Student misconduct is defined as any student behavior that violates rules of the Ringling College of Art and Design as stated in the **PreCollege Student Handbook** or contained within any College publication; and/or is in violation of state, local or federal laws and ordinances. _____ (Initial)
- Involvement in illegal activities, possession of illegal substances, or other actions deemed inappropriate by the College administration will result in **automatic dismissal**. This includes any disruptive behavior or actions seen to be harmful to the welfare of themselves or the community regardless of the sanction policy. Failure to observe the rules and regulations of the PreCollege will also result in dismissal. If a student is dismissed from the program, there is no refund. _____ (Initial)
- Ringling College expects all members of the community to use electronic communications (whether or not they are owned by the College) in a responsible manner. Violations targeted at individuals or classes of individuals, or at the institution or its activities will not be tolerated. Specific examples of behavior that is in violation are noted in the Code of Conduct – Responsible Use of Electronic Communication in the Student Handbook. _____ (Initial)
- Tobacco use of any kind, *including e-cigarette devices*, is strictly prohibited during PreCollege. _____ (Initial)
- During PreCollege, riding in cars with ANYONE, including family members, is strictly prohibited without the express permission of the Dean of Students or Associate Dean of Students. _____ (Initial)
- During PreCollege, students may not have or use skateboards, bicycles, cars or other motor vehicles (moped or motorcycles, etc.). All residential students arriving unaccompanied by car must turn in their keys to the PreCollege/Office of Public Safety at check-in. Keys will be returned at check-out from PreCollege. _____ (Initial)
