PLASTIC CONTAINERS:

Acceptable:

All CLEAN plastic containers

Unacceptable:

Dirty containers	Plastic film
Lamination	Wrappers
Packing materials	Styrofoam

PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Acceptable:

Office paper	Newspaper
Magazines	Journals
One-ply cardboard	Envelopes
Tissue boxes	Flattened cardboard boxes

Unacceptable:

Anything contaminated with food	Anything coated in wax
Tissue paper	Paper towels
Laminated paper	Napkins
Padded envelopes	Spirals from a notebook
	Paper or Styrofoam cups

ALUMINUM OR TIN

Acceptable:

Empty drink cans	Clean food cans
Aluminum foil	Pie tins

Unacceptable:

Aluminum or tin that is contaminated with food or liquids	Other metal items

GLASS

Acceptable:

CLEAN glass jars and bottles

Unacceptable:

Lids	Broken glass
Bulbs	Any tempered glass

CARDBOARD AND/OR SHIPPING MATERIALS

Acceptable:

Corrugated cardboard	Mailing or shipping boxes
----------------------	---------------------------

Unacceptable:

Cardboard that has been contaminated with food (for example, pizza boxes)
Packing materials (bubble wrap, peanuts)
