The GI Bill® at Ringling College

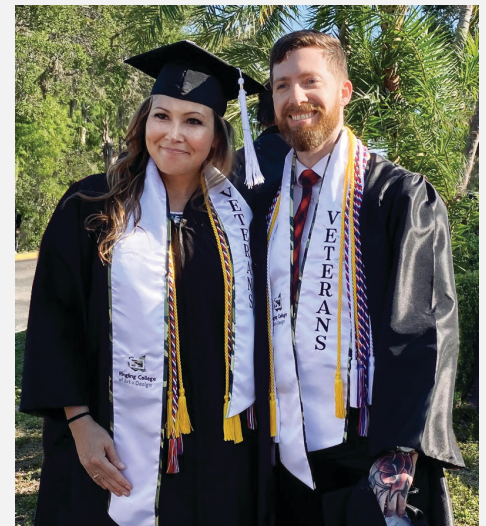

Some highlights Ringling College provides for our military affiliated students include:

- A dedicated, full-time VA School Certifying Official (SCO) in the Office of Financial Aid
- Participation in Post 9/11 GI Bill® Yellow Ribbon, offering additional financial assistance for those who qualify
- Deferment of tuition and fees payment issued when using VA education benefits
- Priority Registration each semester given to students using VA Education Benefits
- VA Work-Study positions

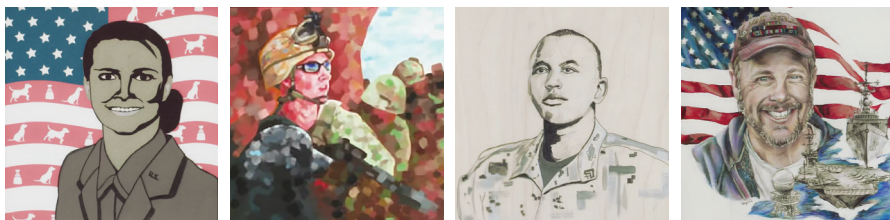
Get Involved! Join our Veteran's Club
