We're Here to Help

Ringling College of Art and Design's Office of Financial Aid has dedicated full-time financial aid advisors to help guide students and families through the financial aid process.

We coordinate the following key financial aid options:

Ringling Scholarships

- Ringling Scholarships with amounts that range from \$3,000 to \$16,000 per year.
- Scholarships are merit-based and determined by portfolio and GPA during the admission process.

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- For US Citizens or eligible non citizens
- Online Application at www.studentaid.gov
- Federal Verification Process with Inceptia
- FAFSA application can be selected for verification by the US Department of Education, verification must be completed
- Ringling partners with Inceptia Federal Verification Gateway: ringling.verifcationsgateway.org

Outside Scholarships

Students receiving any kind of financial aid from any sources other than Ringling College, must report the scholarship information to the financial aid office.

- Provide a copy of the notification letter received from the organization offering the scholarship.
- Financial Aid Office will post to the billing account as anticipated aid.
- Remember to track if it is needed to reapply each year.

New to Ringling College?

Here are the steps to be expected

1. Apply to Ringling College of Art and Design by completing the Common Application.

Review the additional application requirements www.ringling.edu/admissions

2. Submit all final official transcripts reflecting graduation dates or completion dates.

3. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov and use Ringling's school code 012574.

4. View your Financial Aid by logging into Workday from the My.Ringling.edu Portal.

5. If using Federal Student loans student must complete Entrance Counseling and MPN (Master Promissory Note) at www.studentaid.gov.

Differences between the Office of Financial Aid and the Bursar/Billing Office

Office of Financial Aid

- Determine eligibility for Financial aid programs
- Coordinates awarding institutional, federal, state, and outside aid
- Coordinates awarding loans from federal and private lenders for students and parents
- Disburses financial aid to student's account so Billing Office can receive funds

Bursar/Billing Office

- Assess tuition, fees, room and board charges on student accounts
- Account billing and collection of payments
- Handle all 529 or Florida Prepaid programs. Must communicate each year regarding the program you are using
- Oversee monthly payment plan options administered by Transact/Cashnet
